

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PLACING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 4.04 POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CAMPBELL CITY CHARTER ON THE NOVEMBER 5, 2013 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELL, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 4.04 of the Campbell City Charter Police Department which reads as:

SECTION 4.04 THE POLICE DEPARTMENT: The Police Chief shall be appointed by the Mayor from within the ranks of the Police Department according to the Civil Service Laws of the State of Ohio and the Civil Service Provisions of the Charter.

Be and the same and is hereby amended to read as:

The Police Chief shall be appointed by the Mayor, without consideration of Civil Service testing or other examination, said appointee to be drawn from the ranks of the most senior rank then existing within the Police Department, and subject to the majority approval of the Council. The individual so nominated and appointed shall remain incumbent in that position until otherwise removed by the Mayor, with the concurrence of two-thirds (2/3) of the Council, or until the expiration of the term of the Mayor who has originally made the appointment of the individual holding the position of Police Chief. The position of Police Chief shall not be a part of the classified service of the City effective with the first appointment made pursuant to this provision after its enactment; however, this provision shall not effect the status of the individual serving as the Police Chief should that individual have been appointed pursuant to the prior appointing provisions of the Charter relative to the position of Police Chief.

SECTION 2. That the ballot language shall read as follows:

SHALL THE CHIEF OF POLICE BE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR WITHOUT CONSIDERATION OF CIVIL SERVICE TESTING AND SUBJECT TO THE MAJORITY APPROVAL OF CITY COUNCIL FROM WITHIN THE MOST SENIOR RANK EXISTING IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

____ For the charter amendment.
____ Against the charter amendment.

SECTION 3. That this charter amendment shall not affect the person currently holding the position of police chief. That the current person holding this position shall retain the police chief position until his retirement. Upon retirement of the person holding the position of police chief, the position of police chief shall be governed by this charter.

SECTION 4. That the Clerk of Council is hereby ordered to deliver said copy of this proposed Charter Amendment to the Mahoning County Board of Elections to be placed on the November 5, 2013 General Election Ballot.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
