On Election Day I am a candidate for re-election to the position of Director of Law of Campbell. I have been your Director of Law for over 15 years, serving currently since December 2011, and previously from 1996- 2007.

I graduated from Campbell Memorial in 1985, Youngstown State University in 1989, and The Cleveland-Marshall College of Law in 1992. I have been licensed to practice law in Ohio for almost 23 years. My private law office is located in Salem, and I handle legal matters in all Northeast Ohio courts. I have also served on the City's Charter Review Commission and as Visiting Judge for the Campbell Municipal Court.



My availability to our law enforcement personnel has been on a 24 hour a day, seven days a week basis. I have now prosecuted over 7,000 criminal and traffic cases as Prosecutor for our Municipal Court. Proudly I have worked with our Police Officers to combat crime in our City, especially the prosecution of illegal narcotics brought into Campbell. Since returning to my duties in December 2011, over \$185,000.00 has been seized in drug-related offenses – money that has been directly applied toward the purchase of the latest in law enforcement equipment for our Police Department – at no cost to taxpayers.

In the past year, enforcement of our residential property maintenance codes has been stepped up. With City Council and the Administration, we have teamed together to hold accountable landowners to maintain their properties so to enhance the quality of life in Campbell.

Equally important to me, is fulfillment of the strong sense of civic commitment and duty to my hometown, not only in elective office, but by supporting our organizations. Focusing on programs for our youth has been my priority. I am proud to be a Founding Trustee of the Campbell Alumni Association and a donor to all its scholarship efforts; a sponsor in the Campbell Flag Football League since its founding; and, a sponsor of Little League baseball. Each year I look forward to coordinating Civic Day activities for our graduating seniors. As a member of St. Michael's Byzantine Rite Catholic Church, I serve on the Parish Council.

For over 15 years now it has been a daily privilege to apply my experience to representing the City on a full range of legal issues. It is my pledge to continue in this next two year term to provide quality, zealous and independent representation to the City of Campbell. I will be honored by your vote on Election Day and I encourage each of you to exercise your fundamental right to vote on November 3.
